The Martin County Board of County Commissioners is pleased to invite you to participate in an exciting, innovative program designed to provide residents a detailed look into Martin County government. Interested citizens are encouraged to attend Martin County CARES, the Citizens Academy & Resource Education Series.

Why Martin County CARES? We want to familiarize residents with the function and purpose of Martin County government, thus increasing citizen awareness of the variety of services offered by local government. Participants hear presentations from all of the departments under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners, as well as each of Martin County's Constitutional Officers: Supervisor of Elections, Sheriff, Tax Collector, Property Appraiser, and the Clerk of the Courts. One session is also dedicated to a in-depth look at the Martin County School District. Field trips are arranged to many County facilities including the Emergency Operations Center, parks, a water treatment plant and even the County jail!

Through Martin County CARES, participants will personally get to know the key service providers who oversee the diverse operation of the departments that provide roads, water service, parks, emergency medical services and law enforcement. Upon completion of the program, participants will have first-hand knowledge of the organizational structure and function of County government which will enable them to share information with friends and neighbors.

Each CARES "class" is comprised of 40-50 citizens (spouses welcome) participating in a series of sessions held once a week over a six-week period. Classes begin early in the morning with beverages and a snack (8:00 am) and conclude following a working lunch (usually between 2:00 and 3:00 pm).
